		Review the assignment guidelines carefully.
		Note what your professor wants you to pay specific attention to.
		Print both assignment guidelines and the reading whenever possible. Enlarging the font or copying pages from a text so you can make notes and highlights may also help. Create a timeline for reading, breaking it into sections.
		Find a quiet place to read where you won't be interrupted. Consider wearing noise canceling headphones.

		What have you learned about the topic from class?
		What questions do you have about the topic?
		Does the title help you understand what the reading might be about?
		Consider searching and reviewing historical timelines before reading to help with understanding historical and literary topics.
	Tal	king notes while reading will help when you begin writing.
		Create a file or keep notes while reading. Stop and briefly summarize what you have read so far.
		Define concepts/terms mentioned in the guidelines and the reading that you are unsure of.
		Keep notes on main points while reading, and note the page/paragraph numbers.
